The Inconvenient Truth About 2007 Bordeaux

A difficult vintage yields light, simple red wines

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As one wine producer told me today after I tasted his barrel samples of 2007 Bordeaux, "It's a so-so vintage. We can't really expect much out of it."

I have to agree. I have spent the better part of this week in Bordeaux, and have so far tasted nearly 150 wines, in château cellars and blind tastings at my hotel. The 2007 vintage will never be remembered as a serious vintage, or even a good year. It's average quality at best, producing aromatic, lightly fruity and finely tannic wines. They will be quickly drunk and forgotten. (My first set of reviews, posted today, includes 77 wines from the Left Bank. More reviews will be posted early next week.)

The only thing memorable about the vintage is how some producers managed to make very good wines against all odds. For example, I just got back from tasting the 2007 from Château Lafleur, one of the jewels of Pomerol, and the wine showed a wonderful core of ripe fruit and fine tannins and lasted for a minute or two on the finish. Potentially outstanding, Lafleur is clearly among the wines of the vintage.

"We only made a wine like that [by] dedicating ourselves to the vineyard during the growing season," said Baptiste Guinadeau, who works the 15 acres or so of vineyards with his father, mother and girlfriend. "We worked as a family to get the most out of the vineyards in 2007."

Hard work in the vineyards was necessary for anyone who wanted to make good wine in 2007. The summer was one of the worst ever in the region, with gray, wet and cold weather in June, July and August that led to disease in the vineyard. If it hadn't been for the beautifully sunny and hot weather in the first two weeks of September, the vintage would have been a complete disaster. To get the most out of the vineyards, growers and their workers spent thousands of man-hours treating their vines, cutting back grape bunches and fine-tuning leaf canopies. Alas, many growers in Bordeaux had neither the resources nor the expertise to do so.

"The good weather in September and October saved the vintage," said Jean-Hubert Delon, the owner of Léoville Las-Cases in St.-Julien. His 2007 was one of the best young reds from the Médoc in my tastings. "The 2005 was so easy by comparison. Everyone made good wines then. The 2007 was really hard."

Indeed, the very good to excellent wines are few and far between. I already knew it was going to be like that from the outset; when Mother Nature is mean-hearted during the growing season, the wines tell the tale. After 25 years of visiting Bordeaux and tasting young wines from barrel, I have seen it all before. The grapegrowing conditions meant a weak vintage, along the lines of 1984, 1987, 1993, 1994, 1997 and 1999. The only question was: Just how bad would it be?

The expected lack of quality is why I cut down the number of 2007 wines I would taste from barrel to about 250, when I taste two or three times that amount in normal or good years.

Luckily, I didn't find many green or unripe wines. But many wines, particularly in the Médoc, were diluted, hollow, short or showed all of these defects together. I found more pleasant and delicately

fruity wines from the Right Bank appellations of Pomerol and St.-Emilion. I still need to taste a range of wines from Péssac-Leognan and other parts of the Graves.

There is one brilliant light shining through the gray of 2007: the white wines. Both sweet and dry whites appear to be excellent. I have only tasted about a dozen Sauternes so far, but they are racy, rich and long. They remind me of the excellent 1988s when they were young, or slightly more reserved versions of the 2001s. The dry whites are equally racy; the Sémillons are some of the richest yet liveliest I have ever tasted at this stage of their evolution.

But such successes will not be enough to change the reputation of what appears to be nothing but a pretty mediocre year for the region. "It's pretty boring tasting these wines," said one winemaker today. "We can always look forward to 2008."

2007 Bordeaux: Good but Nothing Special

In a difficult vintage for most Left Bank and Right Bank reds, Pessac-Léognan, Sauternes and dry whites shine

Bordeaux is introducing its 2007 vintage to the world, but instead of generating excitement, this year the process has felt monotonous. So many people were just going through the motions: Pour the wine ... say how good it is for the vintage ... smile ... next.

I don't blame anyone. Tasting a range of 2007s can be pretty boring. I tasted nearly 300 wines over the past seven days. It's clear that 2007 is a good but nothing-special vintage for most of the well-known wines of Bordeaux. Sauternes and dry whites are the exceptions; they can be fabulous. And there are a few outstanding reds as well. But overall, I am not sure the new vintage is even on the same level as 1999.

I give the 2007 reds a tentative vintage rating of 84-87 points for the Left Bank and 85-88 points for the Right Bank (on *Wine Spectator*'s 100-point scale).

It's clear that this will not be a vintage for consumers to buy as futures. However, if producers are reasonable with prices, 2007 will deliver some pretty wines for early drinking that can be enjoyed while waiting for the 2005s, '03s and '00s to mature.

This all said, however, the wines are much better than anticipated considering the bad weather during the growing season. The Bordelais, as I <u>wrote a few days ago</u>, are some of the most gifted vineyard growers and winemakers in the world. In any given harvest, they will get the most out of the vintage.

Yes, there was mildew in the vineyards. And yes, there was a lot of rain. But they are used to that, and the top estates have the resources and know-how to compensate for such difficulties. What they can't improve upon, however, is a lack of sunshine—at least not yet! 2007 lacked sunshine until the end of August and then it only lasted for a little more than two weeks.

So the best reds came from the vineyard areas that were the most precocious, as well as those with the best drainage. "Vineyards with gravelly soils did the very best," commented Christian Moueix, whose family owns and runs some of the most prestigious names on the Right Bank, including châteaus Pétrus, Trotanoy and La Fleur-Pétrus.

The wines of the vintage are Château d'Yquem, the great Sauternes, and Haut-Brion White (both 97-100 points). Then among the reds, Ausone, Lafleur, Mouton-Rothschild and Le Pin (90-93) and Haut-Brion and Pétrus (89-92).

The most consistent appellation for reds was Pessac-Léognan, where many of the wines were very close to the quality of 2006 (and some might be better). The region's gravelly soil and the châteaus' earlier harvesting helped them in 2007.

The Pomerol appellation was also good, but mainly the top estates located on or just off the famous clay knoll. Top wines include such names as Pétrus, Le Pin, Lafleur, L'Église Clinet, Vieux-Château-Certan, Certan de May, L'Evangile and La Conseillante. Certan de May may have made a better wine

in 2007 than 2006, due to improvements in winemaking and vineyard techniques. Lesser names made reds that are good but nothing special.

I had hoped St.-Emilion would be up at the same level as Pomerol, but I think that many châteaus tried to push their wines too much through concentration and extraction. The concentrating machines (mostly using reverse osmosis) were on full throttle in 2007 to cut some of the diluted juice, but there was very little goodness in the grapes to concentrate. This led to slightly dry and austere young reds from producers who went for too much concentration.

The Médoc was a bit of a minefield, with very good to weak reds in 2007. It appears only the very best estates could afford to make draconian selections in their vineyards to get the best grapes, though it paid off for those that did. Otherwise, most of the well-known, lower-ranked estates made good reds, but again, nothing special.

I was surprised by the quality of some wines from lesser appellations, including Côtes de Franc, Côtes de Bordeaux and Côtes de Castillon. A number of the wines were fresh and fruity with light tannins and clean flavors. I think that these properties had less to work with so they focused on harvesting and selecting ripe, clean grapes and nothing more. They didn't try to do too much with their winemaking either, meaning they didn't overextract.

"It cost me a lot, but I worked hard on getting only the best grapes we had into the fermentation vats," said Pierre Lurton, who makes a simple Bordeaux called Marjosse at his home estate in Entre-Deux-Mers, as well as manages the great estates of Cheval-Blanc and Yquem.

Nonetheless, the basic wines of Bordeaux are not expected to be very good in 2007. Some wine merchants and winemakers said the thousands of growers and wine producers in the region had few resources to treat their vineyards and cut back their crops in 2007. So they made very poor wines. As a result, some wine merchants will not be making their house wine blends in 2007. Who knows where these wines will be sold. This threatens to exacerbate the financial crisis so many small growers in Bordeaux are already facing.

How to sell the 2007 wines is a big question for Bordeaux. It's all about lowering prices. The general expectation is that prices for the expensive wines of Bordeaux will drop significantly in light of the lower quality of most in 2007, compared to other more recent vintages. This will not be a vintage for speculation in any sense of the word, or part of the world. Moreover, the world economy is in pretty bad shape. Many expect that the U.S. market will be completely out of the futures game with the dollar now close to \$1.60 to the euro. The British pound has lost 15 percent against the euro, so they may also sit out of the game.

A lot of château owners told me that they were not worried about any of that because they had new customers, and new economies such as China, Russia and India are really coming on line now for premium Bordeaux. I have spent a good deal of time in the Far East over the past few years, and I tried to explain to the Bordelais that these markets are not futures markets. These customers like to buy wines in bottle and consume them upon arrival. Moreover, the stock markets of China and India are also volatile, like other key markets at the moment, and I am not sure the affluent are ready to buy a new vintage of Bordeaux.

The château owners and managers didn't look convinced. "Why ruin our lunch?" asked one in the Médoc, as we discussed the market during a meal last week.

Whatever happens, the 2007s will one day find a market, and consumer demand will set the prices. For example, 1997, another good but not great year (85 points for the Left Bank, 86 points for the Right Bank), initially sold at high prices as futures to négociants and importers, but when the wines came on the market in bottle, they could only be sold to consumers by reducing prices below cost. Even now,

they are very cheap compared to more recent vintages. They were overpriced from the beginning.

"I think that 2007 is a friendly vintage, and it should be sold at friendly prices," said John Kolasa, the manager of Rauzan-Ségla and Canon, two châteaus that made very good wines in 2007. "This is our chance to reach out to the consumer and welcome them back to Bordeaux with good wine for good prices."

Wouldn't that be great for everyone concerned who loves a good bottle of Bordeaux?

Simple and fruity, with blackberry and mineral. Medium and enjoyable now. —J.S.

A bit hard, but good raspberry fruit and dark chocolate. Medium body. Medium finish. —J.S.

A fruity wine, with a slightly hollow midpalate, but clean and attractive. Medium tannins and a fresh finish. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU LA LAGUNE Haut-Médoc 2007 Score: 84-87

Very pretty, with blackberry, light vanilla and a coffee bean character. Medium-to-full body, with ultrafine tannins and a long, clean finish. —*J.S.*

Very pretty fruit for the vintage, with blackberry, currant and lightly smoky oak. Medium-bodied, with fine tannins and a fruity finish. Refined and delicious. —*J.S.*

Very attractive crushed berry aromas follow through to a medium body, with ripe, almost sweet berry on the center palate. Long and fruity. —*J.S.*

Lovely aromas of blackberry and chocolate on the nose, following through to a medium body, with fine tannins and a clean and fresh finish. This represents 50 percent of the production in 2007. —*J.S.*

Fruity and velvety young red, with berry, violet and sweet tobacco character. Medium body, fine tannins. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU BOYD-CANTENAC Margaux 2007 Score: 85-88

Bright berry aromas, with hints of flowers, follow through to a medium body. Ripe tannins and a medium finish. A bit hollow. -J.S.

CHÂTEAU CANTENAC-BROWN Margaux 2007 Score: 85-88

Gorgeous nose of crushed berry and currant. Medium-bodied, with pleasing fruit and tannins. Medium finish. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU CHANTELUNE Margaux 2007 Score: 85-88

Berry and currant on the nose and palate. Medium-bodied, with fine tannins and a short finish. —J.S.

CHÂTEAU FERRIÈRE Margaux 2007 Score: 85-88

A fresh and easy young red, with plum and cherry character, medium body, fresh acidity and a clean finish. — *J.S.*

CHÂTEAU GISCOURS Margaux 2007 Score: 85-88

Raspberry and mineral aromas and flavors follow through to a medium body, with good fruit and a light finish. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU LASCOMBES Margaux 2007 Score: 85-88

Berry and floral character, with medium body, medium tannins and a short finish. — J.S.

MAROJALLIA Margaux 2007 Score: 85-88

Good core of fruit, with blackberry and mineral character. Medium body, fine tannins and a medium finish. —*J.S.*

PAVILLON ROUGE DU CHÂTEAU MARGAUX Margaux 2007 Score: 85-88

A fresh and fruity young red, with currant and light vanilla aromas and flavors. Even a little white truffle. Medium-bodied, with fine tannins and a delicate finish. -J.S.

CHÂTEAU BRANE-CANTENAC Margaux 2007 Score: 84-87

A bit lean, but some pleasant berry and spice character. Medium-bodied, with fine tannins and a medium finish. — *J.S.*

CLOS MARGALAINE Margaux 2007 Score: 84-87

Berry and chocolate aromas and flavors, but rather dilute, with fine tannins and a light finish. —J.S.

CHÂTEAU D'ISSAN Margaux 2007 Score: 84-87

Rather lean, with some berry and currant character, mineral and mint undertones. Light finish. —J.S.

CHÂTEAU LA GURGUE Margaux 2007 Score: 83-86

Some currant and berry character on the nose and palate. Medium-to-light body. Firm tannins, with a slightly metallic undertone. -J.S.

CHÂTEAU LABÉGORCE-ZÉDÉ Margaux 2007 Score: 83-86

Plummy and perfumed on the nose. Medium-bodied, with good fruit, fine tannins and a light finish. — *J.S.*

CHÂTEAU DU TERTRE Margaux 2007 Score: 83-86

Some berry, with a fresh herb undertone. Medium body, fine tannins and a short finish. —J.S.

CHÂTEAU LABÉGORCE Margaux 2007 Score: 82-85

Lean, but has some clean berry and mineral character in a light-to-medium body. — J.S.

CHÂTEAU BELLEVUE DE TAYAC Margaux 2007 Score: 81-84

Attractive berry and rose character on the nose and palate. Medium body, but short and dilute. — J.S.

CHÂTEAU POTENSAC Médoc 2007 Score: 86-89

A balanced and fruity red, with mineral, violet and berry character. Medium-to-full-bodied, with refined tannins and a clean, fresh finish. I like this better than 2006. — J.S.

Berry and mineral character turns slightly herbal. Light body. Austere finish. — J.S.

CHÂTEAU LOUDENNE Médoc 2007 Score: 80-83

Light, with some fruit, but turns herbal and short. —J.S.

Pretty young wine, with blackberry and chocolate aromas and flavors. Medium-bodied, with soft, velvety tannins and a medium finish. — *J.S.*

CHÂTEAU MOUTON-ROTHSCHILD Pauillac 2007 Score: 90-93

Wonderful perfumes of flowers, currant, blackberry and violet. Full-bodied, with very fine tannins and a caressing texture. Long and balanced. Very, very pretty. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU LAFITE ROTHSCHILD Pauillac 2007 Score: 89-92

Very new Lafite, with firm, yet polished tannins and subdued currant and sweet tobacco character. Long and structured. Racy. -J.S.

CHÂTEAU LATOUR Pauillac 2007 Score: 89-92

Very pretty and refined, with wonderful, silky tannin texture and ripeness. Full and harmonious, with lots of fruit at the end. A reserved and subtle wine. — *J.S.*

CHÂTEAU CLERC MILON Pauillac 2007 Score: 88-91

Currants and licorice, with a floral character on the nose and palate. Medium-to-full body, good fruit and fine tannins. Balanced and pretty. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU GRAND-PUY-LACOSTE Pauillac 2007 Score: 88-91

Plenty of subtle cassis and floral aromas follow through to a medium-to-full-bodied palate, with fine tannins and a fresh finish. Pretty wine. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU PICHON-LONGUEVILLE-BARON Pauillac 2007 Score: 88-91

Impressive concentration for the vintage, with plenty of currant and berry on the nose and palate. Medium-to-full body, fine tannins and a medium finish. Well done for the vintage. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU PICHON-LONGUEVILLE-LALANDE Pauillac 2007 Score: 88-91

This is very firm and racy, with good fruit concentration. Medium-to-full body, chewy tannins and a medium finish. Very good density for the vintage. Wait and see. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU PONTET-CANET Pauillac 2007 Score: 88-91

Crushed blackberry, currant and light licorice. Full-bodied, with lovely ripe tannins and a long, fruity finish. Balanced and refined. A beauty. —*J.S.*

LES FORTS DE LATOUR Pauillac 2007 Score: 87-90

Refined, with layers of polished tannins and a subtle and delicate palate. Medium-bodied, with lovely length and finesse. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU HAUT-BATAILLEY Pauillac 2007 Score: 87-90

Very pretty, with berry and sweet tobacco character. Medium body, fine tannins and a fresh and fruity finish. Delicious already. — *J.S.*

CHÂTEAU D'ARMAILHAC Pauillac 2007 Score: 86-89

A little short right away, but shows attractive berry and chocolate character on the nose and palate. Medium body, soft tannins and a long, caressing finish. Slightly hollow in the mid palate. -J.S.

CARRUADES DE LAFITE ROTHSCHILD Pauillac 2007 Score: 86-89

Balanced and very pretty, with refined tannins, medium body and delicious berry, chocolate and light spice. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU DUHART-MILON ROTHSCHILD Pauillac 2007 Score: 86-89

A bit angular, with licorice, tobacco and berry character. Tar too. Medium-to-full body, firm tannins and a medium finish. Slightly hollow midpalate. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU HAUT-BAGES-LIBÉRAL Pauillac 2007 Score: 85-88

Berry and fresh herb character on the nose, with medium body, firm tannins and a short finish. —J.S.

CHÂTEAU LYNCH-BAGES Pauillac 2007 Score: 85-88

Berry and currant on the nose and palate, with medium body, fine tannins and a slightly dilute finish. —*J.S.*

LE PETIT MOUTON DE MOUTON-ROTHSCHILD Pauillac 2007 Score: 85-88

Attractive blackberry and toasted oak, with plenty of tar and licorice on the nose and palate. Full-bodied, with good fruit and ripe tannins, but slightly hollow in the center palate. Second wine of Mouton. Seems better than the 2006. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU CORDEILLAN-BAGES Pauillac 2007 Score: 84-87

Plum, berry and mineral character on the nose and palate. Medium body, fine tannins and a delicate, fruity finish. -J.S.

CHÂTEAU GRAND-PUY-DUCASSE Pauillac 2007 Score: 84-87

Good berry and currant character, with a coffee bean undertone. Medium body, lightly chewy tannins and a light finish. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU PIBRAN Pauillac 2007 Score: 84-87

Currant, blackberry and mineral follow through to a medium body, with good fruit and a light finish. A bit hollow. —*J.S.*

CHÂTEAU BATAILLEY Pauillac 2007 Score: 83-86

Some berry and currant character, but slightly angular, with lightly green tannins. Medium body. — J.S.
